As seen in the photos, the building's exterior design incorporates the Vedic style of architecture. The nine two-story Vedic arches standing in one row give the building a unique, elegant, and majestic appearance. Not to mention the expansive central gable on the roof, which offers a breathtaking view of the surrounding beauty. We can

confidently state that it is exactly how Maharishi envisioned a Maharishi Peace Palace should look like.
